



## **Tips for Chromebooks/Ipads in Cold Weather**

- ❖ **Never leave a Chromebook/Ipad/Laptop, even in a well-padded and insulated case in the trunk of a vehicle in cold weather. The machine could freeze and you lose all data contained in it.**
- ❖ **Once you bring the device in from the cold-allow it to warm up to room temperature before rebooting or turning it on.**
- ❖ **Do not use devices such as mug warmers or pocket warmers to heat or keep the device warm. They could heat the wrong parts of the laptop or cause it to generate too much heat and melt internal components.**
- ❖ **Do not use heating pads or other external sources of heat to warm up or thaw the device. Allow the device to warm up on its own and do not “boot” up if you suspect the display is frozen.**
- ❖ **Do not use the device while it is still inside the case. There is no room for air to circulate and you will get heat build-up.**
